Restore II Report

The planned sod coverage is in place for now. Watering the sod is a challenge but will yield great results as we proceed.

Most all the steel and truss structure is in place over the whole construction area. Note the decking taking its place on top of the truss areas. We need to complete this process; next the shingles will be applied over all areas. All the yellow insulation sheets will soon be in place. Windows and doors will appear soon.

The electrical lines from old to new areas are almost in place. As noted before, these lines passed through the Fellowship Hall ceiling. Once the roof is in place a bee hive of activity will take place inside.

Soon we will have less traffic interruption in the front areas. We are aware this has caused delays for both front and back entrances. We ask for patience as we strive to return to normal. Remember to pray for Restore II.

New Testament Lesson

1 Timothy 6:6-19 (NRSV)

⁶Of course, there is great gain in godliness combined with contentment; ⁷for we brought nothing into the world, so that we can take nothing out of it; ⁸but if we have food and clothing, we will be content with these. ⁹But those who want to be rich fall into temptation and are trapped by many senseless and harmful desires that plunge people into ruin and destruction. ¹⁰For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil, and in their eagerness to be rich some have wandered away from the faith and pierced themselves with many pains.

11 But as for you, man of God, shun all this; pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, endurance, gentleness. ¹²Fight the good fight of the faith; take hold of the eternal life, to which you were called and for which you made the good confession in the presence of many witnesses. ¹³In the presence of God, who gives life to all things, and of Christ Jesus, who in his testimony before Pontius Pilate made the good confession, I charge you ¹⁴to keep the commandment without spot or blame until the manifestation of our Lord Jesus Christ, ¹⁵which he will bring about at the right time—he who is the blessed and only Sovereign, the King of kings and Lord of lords. ¹⁶It is he alone who has immortality and dwells in unapproachable light, whom no one has ever seen or can see; to him be honour and eternal dominion. Amen.

17 As for those who in the present age are rich, command them not to be haughty, or to set their hopes on the uncertainty of riches, but rather on God who richly provides us with everything for our enjoyment. ¹⁸They are to do good, to be rich in good works, generous, and ready to share, ¹⁹thus storing up for themselves the treasure of a good foundation for the future, so that they may take hold of the life that really is life.
