### Restore II Report

Referring back to our last report much progress has been made. The final asphalt topping is complete on the new parking lot. And as I write this update the lot is being striped. This area will be ready for the Kindergarten start next week. Plans are in place for most of this area ground to be covered with sod or seeded. You are encouraged to drive through this area to experience what a great addition this additional parking is going to be for now and future growth. Note the close location to the new Narthex. Also note the completed new handicap drop off at the front on the Narthex. Yes, there will be new sidewalk connections in this area also.

And yes, note the new steel columns in the Narthex/Bride's room area. The metal wall building continues in the Youth Hall/Music areas. Now you can see the window placements on the front hall too. The truss steel for all of the above is on site and will be installed soon. Also, the exterior wall insulation process will begin which is the forerunner to bricks. We hope much of this work will be complete before our next report in two weeks.

Moving inside the chancel construction is basically complete and covered with plywood. The choir risers and related area is taking shape. And the electrical folks are mapping out main lines from our present building for all connections. Soon you may see ceiling work in Fellowship Hall as the lines progress from main power in basement.

So we remind you to keep Restore II in your thoughts and prayers. It has been a very hot summer and much hard work has been completed. We all look forward to many more completed construction areas.

# Gospel Lesson

#### Luke 14:1, 7-14 (NRSV)

<sup>1</sup>On one occasion when Jesus was going to the house of a leader of the Pharisees to eat a meal on the sabbath, they were watching him closely.

<sup>7</sup> When he noticed how the guests chose the places of honor, he told them a parable. <sup>8</sup> "When you are invited by someone to a wedding banquet, do not sit down at the place of honor, in case someone more distinguished than you has been invited by your host; <sup>9</sup> and the host who invited both of you may come and say to you, "Give this person your place", and then in disgrace you would start to take the lowest place. <sup>10</sup> But when you are invited, go and sit down at the lowest place, so that when your host comes, he may say to you, "Friend, move up higher"; then you will be honored in the presence of all who sit at the table with you. <sup>11</sup> For all who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted.'

<sup>12</sup> He said also to the one who had invited him, 'When you give a luncheon or a dinner, do not invite your friends or your brothers or your relatives or rich neighbors, in case they may invite you in return, and you would be repaid. <sup>13</sup>But when you give a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, and the blind. <sup>14</sup>And you will be blessed, because they cannot repay you, for you will be repaid at the resurrection of the righteous.'
