

We Welcome, Celebrate, and Embrace All





Others remark that the red petals represent the blood of Christ while the white petals represent His purity. At Chamblee First, poinsettias are donated to adorn our altar each Christmas in honor or memory of loved ones. For those who purchased poinsettia(s), please remember to take your plant(s) home following this Christmas Eve service.

Holy Communion
