# Chamblee Kids

We have moved inside until further notice (hopefully permanently) for K-5 programming. If the weather is nice, we will take kids outside as much as possible, but will always be back inside for pick-up. When we move inside, we will begin our new Sunday School curriculum - The Gospel Project for Kids. Kids church will still be a rotating curriculum schedule and we are working our way through Bob Goff's Love Does For Kids.

On Sundays, kids K-5 are dismissed during the 9am service for kid's church. If they are staying for Sunday School, they can just stay from kid's church through the SS hour. If not, parents should pick up following the 9am service in room 223. After SS, (about 10:45) ALL KIDS need to be picked up by a parent. K-2 will be in room 223, and 3-5 will be in room 225. Kids K-5 who are then attending 11am service will be re-dismissed during the service for kid's church. Kids can then be picked up following the 11am service in room 223.

Nursery will be available for infant through preschool during the service. If you need assistance finding the nursery or any other location please don't hesitate to ask an usher, greeter, or any of our staff. In addition to having the nursery, we also have a soothing room located at the back of the sanctuary in the Narthex with a live stream of the service.
