UMCOR - Flood Bucket Collection

In the wake of record flooding in Tennessee and damage across several states from Hurricane Ida, Chamblee UMC will be collecting UMCOR Cleaning Buckets to be deployed for use in recovery efforts. Our goal is to collect at least 50 buckets. You can be a part of this effort in one of three ways:

1. Pick-up a 5 gallon bucket and packing list at Chamblee UMC, follow the directions provided and return your completed bucket by September 26th.
2. Pick-up a supply list, purchase all items and return by September 26th along with a \$5 suggested donation for the bucket. Our youth will be packing all supply donations on Saturday, September 26th.
3. Make a donation for UMCOR Cleaning Buckets at chambleeumc.org/give (click Give Here>choose UMCOR Cleaning Kits). \$75 will cover the cost of one complete kit.
