What to expect during tonight's service

Tonight's service is a scriptural journey from the table of fellowship into the solemn shadows of Christ's final hours. This 90-minute service will begin in the Fellowship Hall with a shared meal and Communion, then move reverently into the Sanctuary for a Tenebrae service.

This Service of Tenebrae will allow us to reflect on Christ's arrest, crucifixion, death, and placement in the tomb. This somber, multi-sensory experience will feature scripture, music, candlelight, and gradual darkness.

During the transition from Fellowship Hall to Sanctuary, 2nd graders and younger are invited upstairs for a special service just for kids.
